### What is an apprenticeship?

An apprenticeship is a work-based programme, combining on the job training and academic college learning. You will work alongside experienced industry specialists for four days of the week, while learning the core theory and any required functional skills at college one day per week.

Apprenticeships can last between one and four years. During that time you will study towards a nationally recognised qualification while learning, first hand, the skills and experience employers are looking for. Apprenticeships are available in a variety of different sectors, and we will help you find the right one for you.

### What are the benefits?

Earn while you learn – An average wage for an apprentice is £102 per week at aged 16 years, though some employers may pay more)

20 days paid holiday per year

On the job training within a regional company

Gain valuable industry experience from professional specialists

Study towards a nationally recognised qualification

Greater chance of employability within your chosen sector
