

PROFICIENCY IN SECURITY AWARENESS

OVERVIEW

This course is designed to give those onboard ship who do not have a designated security duty the essential education and training meeting requirements set out in STCW Code table A-VI/6-1, which supports Chapter XI-2 of the annex to the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS) 1974, as amended and the International Ship and Port Facility security (ISPS) Code.

NB – security awareness training must be undertaken by all seafarers employed or engaged in any capacity on ships which are required to comply with the ISPS Code.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There is no intake restriction for entry on to this course.

ASSESSMENT

Students are continuously assessed during the course and there is a written exam at the end of the course.

Please note: If you are not an EU passport holder, you will require a Student Visitor Visa to attend any course at Tyne Coast College.
